FOR WALK IN APPLICANTS

1. Duly accomplished **Affidavit of Renunciation** and one (1) photocopy;
2. Original valid **Philippine passport** and one (1) photocopy of its data page
(*Original to be returned to applicant after it is cancelled*);
3. Original and one (1) photocopy of **Einbürgerungszusicherung**
(*Original to be returned to applicant*);
4. Self-addressed **envelope** with Euro 3,95 stamps (*Einschreiben*)
[*Certification and Affidavit to be released via mail after five (5) working days*];
5. Fees: Notarial of Affidavit - Euro 22,50
 Certificate of Renunciation - Euro 22,50
 (**CASH PAYMENT ONLY** for walk in applicants)

APPLYING VIA MAIL

*For applicants who cannot appear in person at the Philippine Consulate General in Frankfurt, they may send the above-mentioned requirements by mail (except the fees) provided that the **Affidavit of Renunciation** is signed by a German Notar and authenticated by the State Judicial President (Landgericht) where the Notar is registered.*
